Scripture: Acts 9; Acts 22:12-16; Luke 9:23

1. On a scale of 1 – 10, 1 being “not important at all” and 10 being “mission critical,” rate the importance of being disciplined and discipling others. (Be ready to explain your answer.)
2. What did you learn about Saul of Tarsus that you didn't know before this message?
3. Share about the transformational power of Jesus Christ in your own life.
4. Share with your group/family by filling in the blanks: “I once was _____, but now Jesus transformed my _____.”

5. CHALLENGE: Develop your own version of the 15-second testimony. Then practice it several times with family, friends or group members so you can get used to saying it. Here's an example:

“I once was skeptical about Christianity, but now Jesus transformed my way of thinking. If he can save/rescue/change a sinner like me, he can save/rescue/change you as well. By the way, I worship at Connect Christian Church in Concord. Would you consider watching a service online or visiting in person?”

...OR you can substitute the last bit about church and be more direct about faith in Jesus. You could say, “I am saved only by the grace of God through faith in Jesus Christ. Have you ever thought about trusting and following Jesus with the one life he has given you?”
